MARIKITTEN settled while four wide, moved three wide into the stretch, responded to pressure and edged clear. MISS BRUTUS sprinted clear, held well into the stretch but was worn down late. ARE YOU DANCING outpaced while six wide, entered the stretch five wide and stayed on. ANGELA'S DOUBLE veered out sharply at the start hampering rivals and lodged a mild four wide bid in the stretch. ON THE QUIET was brushed back at the start and passed tired ones in the late stages. HOLLY AT LAW was forwardly placed and faded. MISS BOCEPHUS outrun while five wide, swung six wide into the stretch and was never a factor. BERNT TO RUN failed to menace. FLYIN'FLIRT was pinched at the start and failed to recover. BID ON A DANCER took no part.
