KATHLEEN L, on terms with several rivals in the first flight soon after the break, was allowed to take up a tracking position just off the leaders after the opening furlong, exchanged some contact with AT THE FINISH nearing the bend while moving to terms with the first flight racing under some reserve three deep into the bend, pressed the issue between foes after a half, edged away to a clear advantage nearing midstretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. RIPE TOMATO, reserved in hand in the opening stages, angled six wide gathering momentum nearing upper stretch, then produced her best stride racing between foes in that path in the last furlong to prevail for the place. WILD HOPE, held up off the second flight a bit off the inside in the opening quarter, made steady progress outside a rival to gain striking distance after a half, shifted out five wide in upper stretch to challenge and continued with a mild bid to gain a share. AT THE FINISH, reserved outside foes off the second flight early, advanced four wide to striking distance while exchanging come contact with KATHLEEN L entering the bend, continued with interest to challenge four wide after a half but couldn't sustain that effort through the final quarter. HELLO AGAIN settled outside foes in the opening stages, was fanned seven wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve her position. SECRET KIN, forwardly placed inside foes in the opening furlong, was allowed to track off the leaders nearing the turn, saved ground to upper stretch, moved to challenged along the rail when presented an opening in upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. STEALTH WOMAN, prominent between foes from the outset, was urged to take the lead after the opening furlong while angling to the rail, dueled for command racing into upper stretch and gave way. KIP BERRIES prompted the pace outside a rival while angling inwards racing to the bend but was spent after a half.
