DUNDALK DUST, reserved between foes racing just off the second flight in the opening half, advanced readily to striking distance just off the inside entering the far turn, momentarily awaited an opening after six furlongs while continuing in hand, shifted out five wide in upper stretch to challenge, then wrested command and pulled clear under firm encouragement. SOUPER MISS, held up just off the leaders racing to the backstretch, led the second flight between foes to the far turn, commenced a steady bid to challenge three deep between foes after six furlongs, disputed the issue inside foes into upper stretch but proved no match for the winner in the last furlong. JITTERBUG BLUES tracked the leaders outside foes as part of the second flight in the opening half, advanced to challenge entering the second bend racing four deep, disputed the issue between foes into upper stretch but couldn't match terms with the top pair late. HOME'S THE BEST settled between foes three deep in the opening stages, made some progress in that path racing through the far turn shifted out in upper stretch and made an effort to improve her placing. SWEET LEMON CHELLO, urged to secure terms with a rival on the pace in the opening quarter, pressed the pace between foes racing through the far turn and emptied out in upper stretch. APPLE MARTINI settled near the inside early and never mounted a serious challenge. MISSY BISCUIT tracked just off the leaders in second flight along the rail racing into the backstretch but steadily faded from contention on the far turn. STORMY APRIL, caught wide racing to the backstretch, never seriously menaced. LAKEAWAY, held up out of tight quarters at the start, settled near the inside and never menaced thereafter. DELIGHTFUL DAISY was hustled to the fore while angling to the rail in the opening stages, dueled for command racing into the far turn and gave way abruptly in upper stretch.
