Footnotes

BROTHERS NICHOLAS tracked the leaders unhurried outside foes as part of the second flight racing to the backstretch, made steady progress to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch, wrested command and edged clear under steady handling. GOLD LEGION, reserved in hand along the inside as part of the second flight racing to the backstretch, came through along rail to challenge inside the pacesetter entering upper stretch and prevailed for place honors. COPPER FOREST broke readily to secure a clear advantage along the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the far turn but weakened leaving the furlong marker when failing to contain the winner. ALL IN SLEW, forwardly placed stalking the pacesetter in the opening half, made a brief bid between foes nearing upper stretch but faded in the last furlong. LEMON CUSTARD settled off the second flight while angling to the inside racing to the backstretch and continued evenly into the stretch. TSUNAMI KING tracked unhurried off the second flight outside a rival racing to the backstretch and never mounted a serious challenge. NUMISMATIST, held up out of close quarters racing into the first turn, shifted out entering the backstretch to track the leaders between foes in the second flight, angled four wide nearing upper stretch while being roused to briefly challenge but steadily faded late. INSTILL settled into stride off the inside early but offered no rally.
