Footnotes

SPECIAL ED M D tracked the leaders from just out of striking position five deep under light rating in the opening stages, steadily moved to terms with the first flight four deep racing into the bend, continued with a steady bid to wrest command in upper stretch and drew away under firm handling. LONGER VERSION, unhurried tracking off the second flight between foes in the opening quarter, continued with a steady effort to split foes three deep entering upper stretch and narrowly prevailed for place honors late. JUSTA AVERAGE JOE tracked the leaders just off the inside as part of the second flight, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and was outfinished for second. DEVIL KISSES tracked just off the leaders four deep early, moved to challenge three deep between rivals into the bend and gave way in upper stretch. COME ON MAN joined the pace between foes soon after the break, dueled for command along the inside racing through the turn and gave way leaving midstretch. POWERSFIELD settled between foes in the last flight early, angled to the inside nearing upper stretch gaining some position, shifted out nearing the furlong marker but continued to improve his placing. NO MORE HONEY tracked off the

second flight racing three deep into the bend and continued evenly in that path into the stretch. LUCKY LEHMAN, forwardly placed three deep in the opening stages, briefly pressed the issue between foes racing into the bend but gave way after three furlongs. KAI'S BLESSING never mounted a serious challenge. ATS GOOD, restless in the gate prior to the start, never gained contention. KAIZER TOP was never a factor. WELL SHOOT, forwardly placed along the inside in the opening furlong, was spent after the opening quarter.
