Footnotes

HEART DOCTOR, caught five wide in the opening stages, continued on terms with the first flight racing three deep pressing the pace into the turn, was fanned four wide racing into upper stretch but drew clear late under steady pressure. TWO LIONS, held up in the opening stages while shifting nearer to the inside, angled to the rail racing into the turn, steadily advanced inside foes into upper stretch but proved only second best. PETEIZUM angled inwards prompting the pace between foes racing into upper stretch but had no final kick. CALL M'AVE MAYBE, in touch between foes on the pace in the opening stages, was rated off the first flight nearing the turn, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch and continued evenly. STRONG LUCK, urged along the inside tracking the pace, lacked the needed late response. SAILEN RAY J, urged to dispute the pace while angling to the inside early, dueled for command to upper stretch and gave way. SPECIALIST never seriously menaced.
