HONEY'S ANGLE stalked her stablemate but could not gain and lost the place late. KERRY WOULD was not a factor. SECRETARY ACT tired. SHE'S A DRUMMER showed little. MAC BALU was outrun. SPANISH NITA was through early. GOLD DIGGERS DAWN was bumped hard and shuffled back at the break and never threatened.
