Footnotes

DOCKTOR DEMENTED, prominent along the inside from the break, disputed the lead inside a rival racing in close quarters in the opening half, continued to dispute the issue while shifting a bit off the rail into the second bend, dispatched PAINTED ROCK midway through the far turn, then continued willingly racing into the stretch to turn back another challenge from CAPTAIN AMERICAN leaving the furlong marker to edge clear in a game effort. The latter tracked the first flight from just out of striking distance outside a rival in the opening stages, shifted out on the backstretch while steadily moving to contention, was urged to challenge three deep leaving the midway point of the far turn, drew on terms with the winner nearing midstretch but couldn't best that foe in the closing stages. NO TIME TO KID (IRE) settled into stride along the inside tracking off the second flight in the opening half, angled out four wide racing into upper stretch and continued with an effort to improve position. SILENT BREEZE settled outside a rival behind the second flight in the opening half and lacked a rally. PAINTED ROCK was urged to force the pace outside a rival racing into the first turn while shifting into that foe's path early, duelled for command into the far turn and gave way after six furlongs. VALID DEVIL tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight for a half and steadily retreated nearing upper stretch.
