R. CAMPFIRE was urged to force the pace outside a rival from the break racing into the first turn, shook clear entering the backstretch while remaining a bit off the rail, then held sway throughout while being kept to steady pressure to prove best. TACTICS BEST angled to the inside early tracking just off the leaders, continued with a steady bid inside rivals racing into the stretch to prove best of the others. CHOWDER was urged to the fore along the inside in the opening stages, lost the advantage to the winner while shifting off the rail racing into the backstretch, tracked the leader outside a rival into the far turn and continued willingly to late stages to earn a share while failing to match the top pair. A NICE SLEWISH BOY settled in last racing well off the inside in the opening half, made steady progress while angling out five deep nearing upper stretch and continued in that path while making some belated progress. CREATIVE WIZARD was steadied a bit avoiding TACTICS BEST nearing the first turn, shifted out nearing the backstretch to track the leaders between foes in the second flight, shifted out four wide nearing upper stretch while being urged to advance but steadily faded in that path racing through the stretch. DONT TOUCH MY GOLD angled to the inside early taking up a position behind the second flight, continued in that fashion to the far turn but lacked the needed late response. NO MORE HONEY, caught four wide between foes racing to the backstretch, retreated from contention early. COSTLY KING, caught five wide racing into the first turn, emptied out early. BUDDYBDANCING tracked the leaders three deep between foes as part of the second flight for six furlongs and steadily faded racing through the far turn. MINE SHAFT GOLD never seriously menaced. JINGLE JANGLE settled along the inside early and

never seriously menaced.
