Footnotes

SALLY BEMO ducked inwards at the start, quickly recovered to gain a position just off the pacesetter racing between foes into the turn, shifted out avoiding close quarters on the turn to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch, took charge approaching the furlong marker and was taken in hand late after her rider confirmed the issue was decided. SHARP A shied outwards at the start momentarily impeding GET ME A COCKTAIL, was righted while being prompted to a contending position three deep tracking just off the pacesetter, shifted inwards a bit racing into the turn while moving to force the issue, gained the advantage between calls racing into upper stretch but proved no match for the winner in the closing stages. SPRING FORMAL tracked the leaders under some mild encouragement from out of striking distance near the inside racing into the turn, angled out four deep nearing the furlong marker and made an effort to improve position. DISTANT MESA broke sharply, set the pace along the inside racing into the turn and gave way after a half. GET ME A COCKTAIL, carried out a bit in the opening stages, tracked the leaders four wide racing into the turn from just out of striking distance but had no closing bid. ANN ACCOLADE ducked out at the start losing position to the field and trailed those foes to the stretch.
