Footnotes

TOAST WITH HONEY broke inwards brushing BELLAMAYA, was righted while shifting outside foes tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance, commenced a steady advance three deep on the turn to challenge for command nearing upper stretch, wrested a clear advantage nearing the furlong marker and went clear under some right handed prompting. SING IT OUT tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in the opening stages, made steady progress shifting nearer to the inside to challenge for command between foes nearing upper stretch but proved only second best. ENGLISH ACCENT tracked off the first flight along the rail racing into the turn and continued evenly while shifting off the inside racing through the stretch to earn a share. BELLAMAYA, brushed at the start, was urged to the lead along the inside, set the pace racing into the turn, couldn't fend off the top pair and gave way leaving the furlong marker. LITTLE FRANCES angled in early to track the pacesetter between foes racing into the turn but faded from contention early. WILDWOOD BELLA hopped at the start to break last and trailed the field to the stretch.
