FUN ON THE BAYOU was rated in hand along the rail tracking the leaders as part of the second flight in the opening half, shifted out three wide nearing upper stretch while being prompted to advance and wrested command in time following a prolonged drive. PAPER MAKER, forwardly placed from the outset tracking a rival's pace, commenced an early move to press that foe racing into the far turn, gained the advantage after six furlongs, continued in an extended skirmish past midstretch and just failed to contain the winner while prevailing for place honors. ROAD TO WAR, pulled his way to the fore along the inside in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin along the rail for a half, resisted a rival's challenge on the far turn and into upper stretch but was outfinished for second. MR NUM NUM tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch but continued to make mild progress late to close the gap. MAD GENIUS settled in last racing to the far turn and passed some tiring rivals racing into the stretch. SACRED RANGE tracked off the second flight near the inside in the opening half but never mounted a serious challenge. HIPPODROME was a brief factor between foes in the second flight but steadily faded after a half.
