Footnotes

HOGY, reserved along the rail in last in the opening quarter, gradually gathered momentum while shifting off the inside nearing upper stretch, angled out six wide in upper stretch while steadily drawing on terms with the leaders, then took charge and drew clear under a few left handed taps and firm handling. YANKEE INJUNUITY tracked just off the leaders along the inside under light rating racing into the bend, came through when presented an opening to challenge for command in upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the winner late but held a rival for place honors. WEKIVA WACHEE was rated between foes in the second flight while angling nearer to the inside racing into the bend, continued under patient handling awaiting an opening nearing upper stretch, shifted out four wide to split foes in late stages and edged a rival for a share. UPSELL, forwardly placed outside foes in the opening stages, pressed the issue three wide on the turn to upper stretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. RATATAT tracked the leaders four deep off the first flight racing to the turn, continued in that path while making a brief bid nearing upper stretch but flattened out approaching the furlong marker. PROCEED BEE was urged to the lead racing a bit off the inside in the opening stages, dueled for command inside foes into upper stretch and gave way. BIG LOOIE was urged to secure a forward placing between foes, prompted the pacesetter racing into the turn but retreated from contention early.
