**Footnotes**

DANDYMAN, held up between foes off the second flight in the opening half, split foes nearing upper stretch, then shifted out four deep while being roused to advance and wrested a clear advantage in time under firm handling. STAR OF PARADISE, forwardly placed three deep tracking the pacesetter in the opening stages, pressed the issue in that path nearing upper stretch, couldn't match the winner's kick but continued with interest for the place honors. FIRE CLOUD, held up inside foes in the second flight, shifted out to bid between foes racing into upper stretch and continued willingly to prevail for a share. DEEP DIVE, reserved last racing to the far turn, swung out five wide in upper stretch and continued to make mild progress to the end. HE'S BONAFIDE moved to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the far turn, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way in late stages. CANADIAN WISH tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight racing to the far turn but had no closing response. SHINE THE ROCKET, in touch attending the pace in the opening stages, lodged a brief bid between foes on the far turn but quickly flattened out. BUDDY'S BID settled off the second flight along the inside early and offered no rally. FRANK'S TIME settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never seriously menaced.
