GUNFLINT TRAIL showed no early speed, made a quick move in the upper stretch, lugged in, dueled late in the lane and held on. PURPLE MAJESTY made a steady advance, swung out widest in the second turn, dueled late and just missed. NORTH POINT saved ground, was shut off in the stretch then rallied when clear. BACHICHO vied for the lead inside and tired. MR. SEABRA was carried out in the first turn, vied early, was brushed in the stretch when in tight. SAN SABA was getting out in the first turn, vied early and was used up. PAGAN EVENT was void of early speed and failed to menace. BUG A BOO BEN was through early and no factor. THE FOUNDRY swerved at the start and bore out badly in the turn.
