CLEVER STRIKE saved ground, split horses in the turn, ran down the leaders and got up late. PASSIONATE KIP had a steady advance, altered course inside and finished well. BYENNE had no speed, found her best stride too late and rallied five wide. RIPE TOMATO split horses in the, altered course and made a late gain. GITA set a pressured pace and gave way late. FRANCES CAT went evenly and lacked a late response. SOLE OF THE CITY was never far back, had a brief lead in the stretch then faded between horses. FLASHY LADY raced in the second flight, loomed a threat but was not good enough. TANK GRRRL saved ground and did not rally. SUMMER RECITAL stalked the pace inside, steadied and stopped in the stretch.
