**Footnotes**

TAYLER'S DESTINY, urged to dispute the pace along the rail from the break, turned back a rival's challenge racing into upper stretch and steadily edged clear in the final stages under firm left handed pressure. DOROTHY Y, urged to terms with a rival on the pace, pressed that foe on the turn into upper stretch, couldn't match terms in the last quarter but held well for place honors. VITAE stalked just off the leaders three deep in the opening stages, moved to challenge in that path after a half, but finished evenly in late stages. GAMBLER FIVE settled off the second flight early, advanced to contention four wide racing through the turn but lacked the needed final response. PARTY DANCE settled between foes in early stages, angled to the inside racing through the turn and made an effort to improve position inside foes through the stretch. MYA FACCIA BELLA settled five deep in the last flight early, angled inwards a bit on the turn, shifted out five deep racing to midstretch while gaining some position but made no real impression. ZAP'EM, held up off the second flight tracking the pace near the inside racing into the turn, couldn't produce the needed closing bid. MARK THESCORE EVEN was settled between foes three deep in early stages and never gained contention. I TURNED OUTLAW tracked off the second flight outside a rival racing to the bend and steadily retreated after a half. I'M SOMETHING dropped out of contention early. VICKY'S BAR was a brief factor tracking the leaders in second flight along the inside but gave way abruptly midway through the turn.
