Footnotes

SPEEDY WAR broke sharply to force the pace outside a rival from the outset, dispatched that foe leaving the turn while angling to the inside, then held safe the challenge of HOORAY FOR YALEI through the closing stages under steady pressure. The latter stalked just off the first flight three deep in the opening stages, made steady progress to challenge the leader racing into upper stretch but was always second best. CASSIDILLY tracked just off the first flight four wide racing into the turn and continued willingly in that path to late stages to close the gap while prevailing for a share. COURTESY CALL tracked off the second flight near the inside in the opening stages and made some mild progress between foes racing into the stretch. MARKREE BREEZE broke inwards bumping SANTO RIO, was settled near the inside racing to the stretch and made no real impression. SENORITA CATRINA, required re-saddling just before the start, then was a bit reluctant to load, raced five wide tracking off the second flight racing through the turn to upper stretch and never seriously menaced. LEMONDROPSPRITZER flashed brief pace along the rail disputing the pace but was through after a half. SANTO RIO broke awkwardly, then was bumped at the start and never menaced thereafter.
