Footnotes

DAKOTA DIGGER sped clear of the field racing into the first turn, was a bit rank under rating while maintaining a clear margin racing to the far turn and held sway to the end under firm handling. YANKEE DEALER tracked the pace between foes just off the second flight racing to the backstretch and continued with a steady, three wide advance to close the gap late while always second best. CONTROL TOWER tracked off the second flight near the inside in the opening stages, shifted out four wide on the far turn and continued in that path to late stages while making mild progress to gain a share. NORTH OF NEVER settled outside foes in the last flight early, was urged to advance while being fanned six wide racing into the stretch and made some belated progress. TAKE HEART, held up between foes off the second flight early, angled to the inside on the far turn while gaining some position but had no final

kick. HOT DAMON tracked the leaders near the inside in second flight racing to the far turn but offered no closing bid. FREE FIGHTER tracked the leaders three wide between foes off the second flight racing to the far turn and lacked a closing response. MYSTIC, shuffled back at the start, never seriously menaced. THAW tracked the pacesetter three deep in second flight to the backstretch, made a brief bid nearing the far turn but quickly came up empty. MOONSHINE MULLIN, caught wide to the backstretch, made some progress to advance five wide between foes nearing upper stretch but quickly flattened out. PLEASANT CLOSING was a brief factor leading the second flight between foes to the backstretch but emptied out early. DEFIANT FLYER was never a factor.
