LAMPOON was well placed, waited for room in the turn, split horses and was brushed in the stretch and got up late. STOP A TRAIN was bumped and steadied early, edged to the lead in the turn but couldn't sustain the bid. BOUDOIR was void of early speed, loomed a threat but drifted out in the stretch. LABAR was bumped at the start and made a late rally while gaining six wide. DYNA SLAM raced wide throughout and lacked a late response. MS. LYDONIA was squeezed back at the start and improved position. TUFTED set a pressured pace and gave way in the drive. TOUR D'AURA had good early speed then flattened out while brushed in the stretch. CHEYENNE SPIRIT showed no speed and failed to menace. IRISH ACCENT was off slowly and trailed.
