Footnotes

DAKOTA REBEL was always close up, took the lead in the turn, shook off his rivals, lugged in late and prevailed. RIVER BEAR raced in the second flight, waited for room between horses in the turn, rallied when clear and altered course late. BILLYS BAR BUDDY saved ground, waited for room in the upper stretch, was boxed in and gaining after getting clear. BEST BUDDY was bumped at the start, loomed boldly and drifted out in the stretch. HOLY VESPER was slow early and made a late rally widest. ILLINI DESTINY was never far back, made a bid in the turn and did not rally. FROSTYBDANCING was void of early speed, made a middle move widest and lacked a late response. SOAR SLEW SOAR hesitated at the start and passed tiring rivals. CHIEF WHAT broke through the gate, ran off on the backstretch and then was never a factor. ROCKET RODD was bumped at the start, set the pace, was used up and dropped back. SPANNING THE GLOBE was through early and no factor.
