Footnotes

DUBIOUS, reserved in hand near the inside in the opening half, commenced a steady advance entering the far turn while shifting off the inside, came around foes four wide racing into upper stretch while moving into striking distance, shifted inwards under pressure racing through the stretch but continued with interest to challenge between rivals and wrest command in the closing stages under firm encouragement. STEP SISTER moved to the lead inside foes racing into the first turn, dictated the pace under some reserve to the second bend, drifted out racing through the stretch while being roused to turn back a rival's challenge, brushed MS MANIPULATOR in late stages while gamely resisting that foe but couldn't fend off the winner's final bid. UMMA UMMA tracked the pacesetter inside foes from just out of striking distance early, saved ground to upper stretch while making steady progress, couldn't match the top pair late but edged a rival to maintain a share in the final stages. MS MANIPULATOR bobbed at the start, angled inwards a bit gaining a position in the second flight, split foes racing through the far turn to challenge outside the pacesetter in upper stretch, was carried out, then brushed in late stages and failed to sustain her momentum. RESTLESS STAR tracked just off the pacesetter three deep racing to the far turn but lacked the needed closing bid. ARCHIPELAGO was urged to join the pace outside a rival, couldn't match that foe after a half and steadily retreated racing into upper stretch. LIL CARMELITITA was never a factor.
