Footnotes

COUNT DE BARAN, reserved saving ground tracking just off the second flight in the opening stages, lost some position to the leaders after a half, shifted off the inside commencing a steady advance leaving the far turn, angled six wide nearing midstretch while moving to challenge and edged BRILLIANTBRILLIANT in time under strong handling. The latter was settled outside foes while caught five wide early, made a steady advance in that path to gain striking distance on the second bend, challenged for command in upper stretch, moved to a clear advantage late but couldn't fend off the winner. BIG BEAR HUG tracked the pace between foes from just out of striking distance, advanced to challenge four wide entering the far turn, disputed the issue between foes past midstretch but was outfinished by the top pair. LITTLE FEAT broke slowly while throwing his head at the start, saved ground racing unhurried to upper stretch, shifted out to split foes three wide nearing midstretch and made some mild progress. THRU THE DESERT, forwardly placed between foes from the outset, angled in after a half to bid inside foes leaving the far turn but failed to sustain that effort through the final furlong. CIGAR BREAK was urged to the lead racing to the first turn, dictated the pace off the inside racing into the far turn and emptied out once headed in the drive. HEZA BOXER angled to the inside tracking just off the leaders, saved ground on the second bend and steadily faded in upper stretch. ARDANWOOD was settled near the inside early and never gained striking distance. OUR LAST TRY tracked the leaders between foes in the flight racing to the far turn and came up empty after six furlongs. PEARL EXPRESS joined the pace five wide in the opening stages, pressed the issue three wide between foes into upper stretch

and emptied out. PHIL N MARTY, forwardly placed between foes four deep racing into the first turn, was checked out of tight quarters entering the backstretch and retreated from contention early. ANOTHER TALL TALE never seriously menaced.
