TRIBUTE TO MOMMA broke a bit awkwardly, was settled off the inside racing to the backstretch, made a steady advance to striking distance four deep racing through the far turn, continued to dispute the lead outside a rival past the furlong marker and prevailed late under firm handling. TWO BAYME tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance off the inside racing to the backstretch, advanced to challenge three deep between foes racing through the far turn, moved to a narrow advantage nearing the furlong marker, resisted the winner to the end but came up second best. DARLAND, urged to contention while shifting to the inside racing to the backstretch, continued in second flight briefly awaiting an opening midway through the far turn, shifted out three deep leaving the quarter mile marker and continued well enough to prevail for a share. FOREVER JENNY tracked the pace unhurried off the second flight near the inside in the opening half, angled out four wide racing into upper stretch to gain some position but made no real impression. PROUD PICK shifted off the inside tracking just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, moved to briefly press that foe on the far turn but gave way entering upper stretch. CHAMPAGNE SPIRIT trailed the field to the stretch. SWEET HARP sped clear along the inside racing to the backstretch, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the second bend and gave out abruptly after six furlongs.
