CALL M'EV'E MAYBE joined the pace outside a rival from the break, pressed the issue to gain a clear advantage leaving the midway point of the turn, angled to the rail nearing upper stretch and responded to firm handling to turn back a challenge from SHAMAN leaving the furlong marker to edge clear. The latter was rated tracking off and outside the leaders in the opening stages, shifted in entering the bend to split foes, moved to challenge the pacesetter three deep between foes racing into upper stretch, drew on terms with the pacesetter midstretch but proved no match late. PUMPKIN PUSHER broke awkwardly losing position to the field, raced, four, then five wide into the stretch gaining some position but had no closing bid. I MAKE THE RULES was urged to dispute the pace along the rail racing into the turn and gave way after a half. HOLY ROSIE was rated along the inside racing into the turn from just out of striking distance but lacked the needed closing response. A J MOON tracked just off the first flight early, lodged a brief bid while being fanned four wide nearing upper stretch and quickly emptied out.
