BRIM, reserved out of striking distance along the inside for a half, made a steady advance to contention near the inside racing into the far turn, split foes, then shifted out four wide in upper stretch and produced a solid late response to wrest command and kick clear under firm handling. MY JOKESTER tracked the leaders between foes in second flight from just out of striking distance for a half, made steady progress to gain the advantage racing into upper stretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner while just lasting for place honors. WICKLOW settled in last to the first turn, continued under reserve to the second bend, was roused to split foes just off the inside racing through the stretch and was going well late. DOCTOR TROTTER, bumped, then shuffled

at the start, settled outside foes racing well out of striking distance, shifted widest on the far turn avoiding some traffic commencing his advance, was fanned five wide in upper stretch while moving to challenge but was outkicked. EL TRUENOS tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight racing to the far turn and steadily faded racing into the stretch. SHINE THE ROCKET tracked the pace outside foes off the second flight racing three deep to the far turn and lacked a closing response. JOHAR IRISH was urged to the lead along the inside, dueled for command inside a rival for a half, edged clear racing through the far turn but faltered once he was headed in upper stretch. B. MONSOUR broke in bumping DOCTOR TROTTER, was caught four wide in the second flight racing to the backstretch and soon retreated. HEART DOCTOR tracked the pace three wide between foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch but retreated from contention early. STOLE MY SOUL settled into stride near the inside early but never seriously menaced. THERE'S NO TELLING showed little. LITTLE KICK was urged from the break to force the pace outside a rival racing to the backstretch and emptied out racing through the far turn.
