Footnotes

MISTYMOON LAKE tracked the pacesetter along the rail racing into the bend, made a steady advance near upper stretch to challenge inside the leader for command, came through and drove clear. AND HOW settled off the inside racing to the bend, swung seven wide into upper stretch and continued well enough to prevail for second. POCANELLA tracked off the second flight, altered course avoiding tight quarters entering the bend, split foes four wide to challenge in upper stretch and was just unfinished for second. SEA WHY, urged to position three deep in the second flight, made a brief bid racing into upper stretch but flattened out in late stages. ROYAL RENAISSANCE was hustled clear while angling inside, set the pace on a clear margin into the bend and gave way near midstretch. STORMY RACHEL tracked off the second flight outside foes, continued three, then four deep on the bend, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch but had no rally. HIT A BAD NOTE tracked off the second flight racing to the bend while going a bit erratically nearing the bend and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. SILVER DIRECTION was never a factor. CABOOSIAN LASS was a brief factor four wide chasing the pace but gave way nearing upper stretch.
