MOROCCAN BREW broke a bit awkwardly, was urged to gain a contending position tracking just off the first flight while shifting out three deep in the opening quarter, continued under light reserve tracking the leaders in that path racing into the turn, responded when given his cue to challenge nearing upper stretch, gained the advantage approaching the furlong marker and extended his margin under strong handling to the wire. ROSSCAT broke inwards bumping MY FEVER, was settled outside foes in the opening stages, shifted inwards crossing the path of MY FEVER midway through the backstretch, continued with a steady advance splitting foes entering the turn, shifted to the rail nearing the quarter mile marker to challenge for command in tandem with the eventual winner but proved only second best in the drive. RIVERSHIRE tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance four wide in the opening stages, was urged to challenge in that path racing into upper stretch and continued evenly in the final quarter while going well enough to earn a share. MR. FLEXIBLE was urged to secure the lead from the outset, dictated the pace off the rail racing into the bend, held sway to upper stretch but emptied out once headed by the winner. TURN N' FIRE was rated along the rail tracking the leaders in the opening quarter, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch but lacked a rally. MY FEVER, pinched back at the start, was bothered by ROSSCAT racing through the backstretch and never gained contention. WILD COMMAND angled to the rail early prompting the pacesetter racing into the turn but retreated before a half.
