SONORA'S MOON was not a factor. DOCTOR HILARY lacked speed and improved her position. FLOR DEL SOL was not a factor. BABY BEA lacked speed and showed little. KATIE'S BEST raced near the middle of the field and gave way. MAGNIFICENT raced close up and tired. CRAAM CREEK LADY was through early.
