YANQUEE REIGN checked at the start, lacked speed and rallied belatedly. VID I raced inside but lacked a rally. SILVER CONCORDE lacked speed and improved her position. LINK TO THE PAST raced inside but was not a factor. SAINTLY SCOUT raced close up off the rail and gave way. CALICO N' LACE raced close up off the rail and tired. VALOR WITHIN was always outrun. SENSORIOUS KISS was off slowly and always outrun.
