BIG BEAR HUG leaned out at the start, saved ground, moved four wide into the stretch and rallied. DJEDDAH reserved along the inside, swung five wide into the stretch and stayed on well. MORE THAN ABLE settled along the inside, moved out six wide into the stretch and lodged a mild bid. HERE COMES HENRY gained the lead, was headed leaving the far turn and gave way. SON OF TIGER displayed mild late interest. NEAR PERFECT always outrun. SAM OWEN stalked the pace, was outpaced on the far turn and weakened. UNO PECADOR raced forwardly while three wide and dropped back into the stretch. SILVER EMBER was outpaced while four wide and proved no factor.
