MORALITY raced in striking position while four wide, forged clear into the stretch and held well under vigorous handling. SEVEN MILE BRIDGE gained the early lead, was headed leaving the turn and stayed on well to secure the place spot. MACHO TORO reserved early, swung five wide into the stretch and finished well. GOALTOGOAL raced forwardly while three wide, lost his position on the turn and had no rally in the stretch. DOUBLE SILVER stalked the pace and weakened. TWYLAS RED CAT failed to menace. FLAMING GLORY proved no factor. ESPERANTO was outrun. SIG AND ZAG took no part.
