Footnotes

SIGNSEALNDELIVER tracked the pace between foes in second flight, angled out four wide entering upper stretch while being roused to challenge and prevailed under firm right handed pressure. BOWMAN'S SECRET attended a rival's pace between foes, pressed the issue into upper stretch and was narrowly outfinished. J. PA tracked just off the leaders along the inside, bid along the rail in upper stretch and was just outkicked. NUCKSER, urged along three deep prompting the pace, pressed the pace to upper stretch and weakened late. DOMAIN'S RAP settled off the second flight, swung five wide in upper stretch and made some mild progress. SUNSHINE EXPRESS, urged to the fore racing a bit off the inside in the opening stages, dueled between foes into upper stretch and gave way. RIVERSHIRE broke outwards bumping BOURBON TRAIL, was collected to track outside foes in the second flight and steadily faded. STAR OF PARADISE tracked the leaders along the inside racing to the bend but couldn't produce a closing bid. BOURBON TRAIL, bumped at the start, soon trailed.
