Footnotes

TOO MANY SINS tracked off the second flight near the inside under light rating racing to the bend, shifted out nearing upper stretch to split foes and was roused to advance in close quarters racing through the stretch to prevail in time. VICE LORD tracked off the second flight outside foes early, made a steady advance to contention four deep nearing upper stretch, shifted inwards under pressure while closing the gap to the end and was just outkicked. CITY NUMBER settled near the inside racing to the bend, swung six wide entering upper stretch and produced a solid late response to earn a share. SABAGO tracked the pacesetter three deep in second flight early, made a steady advance on the turn to force the issue racing into upper stretch and was just outfinished by the top pair. PORT HUDSON, reserved well off the pace in early stages, shifted out to improve his position racing five wide through the stretch. GOTCHA CART, caught four deep early tracking off the second flight, never gained contention. THE REAL CHAS tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight but steadily retreated racing through the stretch. OUTLAW ZEN, urged clear along the inside, set the pace to upper stretch and gave way. DEW DETIME tracked between foes in the second flight, shifted out four wide in upper stretch while being urged to challenge but quickly came up empty. ROYALTY OF DUBAI, held up out of tight quarters at the start, trailed throughout.
