Footnotes

DOMINANT SUH, pulling a bit along the inside while attending a rival's pace racing to the backstretch, pressed the issue racing into upper stretch and edged forward in late stages under steady handling in a prolonged drive. **GREYTAP**, urged to secure terms with a rival on the pace, pressed the issue into upper stretch and was just outfinished. **AFLEET PADDY** tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight racing to the second bend, swung out with a sharp move to challenge four wide in upper stretch and made some mild progress to close the gap and gain a share. **GROVE PARK** tracked the pace between foes in the second flight, moved to challenge three deep racing into upper stretch but had no final kick. **NOLANGRANT'SKITTEN** tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch and continued evenly just off the inside to late stages. **MR MOJO RISIN** tracked off the second flight between foes racing to the far turn and continued evenly into the stretch. **GRANDPA GIBBY** settled along the inside early and never gained contention. **DAKOTA MILKSHAKE** tracked the pace between foes off the second flight, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and

lacked the needed final response. BOSS ALLEY settled outside foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. WILD COMMAND tracked the pace three wide in second flight racing to the far turn but dropped out quickly entering upper stretch. STEALTH HERO, caught four wide racing into the first turn, never gained contention.
