DEW DETIME raced in striking position while six wide, entered the stretch four wide, forged clear and held well. KAISER SOZE chased along the inside, angled three wide into the stretch and kept on. PROFESSOR HENNESSY pinched back at the start, was outrun and closed ground through traffic. FIVE STAR JOHN saved ground, swung six wide into the stretch and lodged a mild bid. DUFOURSPITZE grabbed the lead, held well into the stretch and was worn down late. OUR STATUS QUO never menaced. PARADE ROUTE proved no factor. KASYNO was reserved behind the pace and gave no response when called upon. PRINCE ELIAS forced the pace and weakened. BLACKJACK FRANK vied for the lead between foes and faded. TOAST THE GHOST was always outrun. SOLO CONCERTO was outpaced while four wide and managed no rally.
