TURNPIKE TOMMY, reserved off the second flight in the opening half, split foes leaving the midway point of the far turn advancing on the leaders, angled out three deep in upper stretch to challenge, then wrested command and went clear under steady pressure. SWEETEST RHYTHM broke sharply, tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight, shifted out five wide nearing upper stretch to challenge but proved only second best. CHARTER CLASS was urged to a forward placing outside a rival, pressed the issue on the far turn into upper stretch and weakened late. CARTOUCHE tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight, moved to challenge along the rail after six furlongs but flattened out in the drive. STEPS SILVER HALO stumbled at the start, was settled off the inside and continued evenly into the stretch. TWO NINETY FIVE, reserved off the inside in the opening half, offered no rally. CRYPTO GULCH tracked the pace between foes in the second flight, angled out four wide leaving the far turn and soon gave way. BUD SYMONDS settled along the inside early and never mounted a serious challenge. CONDITION RED proved no factor. GOT A QUESTION was urged to the lead inside foes, dueled for command into the far turn and gave way abruptly in upper stretch.
