### Footnotes

SHINE THE ROCKET, held up in the second flight saving ground racing to the backstretch, continued along the inside through the second bend, shifted out in upper stretch to split foes, gained a narrow advantage leaving the furlong marker and gamely held the challenge of EIGHT GAUGE under firm handling. The latter, reserved off the second flight saving ground on both turns, angled out five wide nearing the furlong marker and continued with a steady effort to close the gap. SHOOT THE LOOP, reserved outside foes to the backstretch, swung six wide racing into upper stretch and produced a steady late response to close the gap on the top pair while earning a share. VARACRUZ stalked just off the pacesetter under rating in the opening half, pressed for command between foes racing into upper stretch but had no final kick. SOMEWHERE IN TIME tracked the leaders between foes off the second flight racing to the far turn and continued evenly four deep racing into the stretch. SENATOR DAVE tracked outside a rival in the second flight under reserve in the opening half, made a brief four wide bid racing into the stretch but weakened in the last furlong. CHIEF CHICAGO settled outside foes early, was caught five wide racing through the far turn but offered no rally. BOBBY WITH A WHY moved clear along the inside racing to the backstretch, dictated the pace into the far turn but emptied out once headed nearing midstretch. MAD GENIUS, bumped at the start, was righted to track outside foes off the second flight but steadily faded racing into the far turn. BARANIT settled in last racing to the backstretch and never menaced. MY TIME IS NOW broke inwards bumping a rival, was collected to track outside foes off the second flight but never proved any factor. AWESOME LIMBO, reserved along the inside racing to the backstretch, dropped out nearing upper stretch.
