Footnotes

MY BOY BILL broke inwards bumping TRULY MACHO, was righted to gain a position just off the first flight outside foes racing to the bend, made a steady,

three wide advance to wrest command nearing upper stretch and drew well clear through the stretch under firm encouragement. BLUE DAY IN MAY, bumped, then crowded at the start, was righted to gain a position three deep off the second flight racing into the bend, split foes entering upper stretch and continued with interest to prevail for place honors. INDIAN PROPHET tracked the leaders outside foes off the second flight, continued with a steady bid to gain second racing into upper stretch while never menacing the winner and was outfinished for place honors. FAMILY SIX angled to the inside disputing the pace in the opening stages, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way. JUST BUY ANOTHER settled along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. FOXY ON SUNDAY tracked the pace between foes off the second flight racing into the bend and continued evenly into the stretch. DEPUTY DALE, held up out of tight quarters at the start, never gained contention. HABASAC broke outwards bumping BLUE DAY IN MAY, was guided to the inside tracking just off the first flight racing into the bend but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. CLYDE BANK joined the pace three deep between foes, dueled for command between foes racing into the turn and gave way after a half. TRULY MACHO, bumped at the start, was settled outside foes from out of striking distance and never menaced thereafter. COME CLEAR settled into stride along the inside and soon trailed.
