Footnotes

DANCING FLASHY was prompted to gain a forward placing between foes racing to the first turn, attended a rival's tempo to the second bend, continued with a steady bid to challenge on the far turn, shook clear racing into upper stretch and extended the advantage under pressure. ABBY'S SLEW was rated outside a rival tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance in the opening half, was urged to advance while shifting out five deep nearing upper stretch but continued with interest to prove best of the others. OUR BARRY GIRL, restless in the gate before the start, stumbled at the break losing position to the field, was settled in hand to the backstretch, shifted off the rail on the far turn while being urged to advance, then shifted to the rail entering the lane while continuing with interest to earn a share. SCORPIOBDANCING threw her head while hesitating at the start, tracked the leaders along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out to bid four deep between foes nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. COUNTIN' ON U DOC, urged to a forward placing three deep tracking just off the pacesetter, moved to challenge in that path between foes on the far turn but soon flattened out. LADY SCATTERLEY was urged to the lead along the inside from the outset, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the far turn and gave way.
