### Footnotes

VINO LIMBO TANGO threw his head just after the break while dropping off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages, tracked the leaders along the rail racing into the turn, steadily gathered momentum racing into upper stretch, came through close quarters nearest the rail midstretch to challenge for command and drew away late under pressure. CHAMPAGNE TONY tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight racing into the bend, loomed three wide nearing upper stretch and continued with a steady effort while being fanned four wide late to edge several rivals for the place honors. RIGHT NOW RICHIE angled inwards while being urged to force the pace outside a rival racing into the bend, duelled between foes three deep in upper stretch but weakened late. B S WILDCAT, urged along the inside in pursuit of the leaders racing into the bend while part of the second flight, shifted out in upper stretch, then switched back to the inside nearing the furlong marker while continuing willingly, lost some momentum when losing that path to the eventual while altering his course abruptly to split foes in late stages but continued willingly to the end. GIANNA'S MUSIC MAN was urged between foes to gain the advantage after the opening quarter, pressed the issue along the inside to upper stretch and gave way in late stages. GRAND PROCESSION shifted off the inside early while dropping well off the second flight but never gained contention. MUZZAZ, reserved in early stages, offered no rally. SHOWBIZ IS MY BIZ, urged along between foes chasing the leaders in second flight, retreated early.
