TOO MANY SINS steadied on the first turn, took the lead in the stretch and was much the best in hand. FIRE BREWED was slow early, angled out then found his best stride late and was up for place. DON NICCO pressed the pace off the rail and failed to sustain his bid. HUNTING PRIDE had his shoe fixed in the paddock, saved ground and had a mild bid. SARATOGA VICAR saved ground and had some late run. LABOR UNION was void of early speed and passed tired foes. GONE RACIN raced to the rail, set the pace, led to the stretch and faltered. FLATTER TIME was taken up and shut off in the first turn and failed to menace. GARBOSO steadied early on the inside on the backstretch then dropped back. REIGN AND WIND broke outward at the start and outrun. WILLIE'S MIRACLE raced mid pack early then dropped back and was far back in the stretch.
