KITCHI WARRIOR was guided to the rail in the opening stages tracking the pacesetter under firm rating racing to the backstretch, continued with a steady effort inside foes racing into the far turn, shifted outside the leader nearing upper stretch while willingly moving to terms with that foe, wrested command near the furlong marker and drew clear under firm left handed encouragement. HESHOOHS HESCOCES broke readily to gain the advantage along the inside, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin racing to the far turn, briefly resisted the winner's challenge arcing into upper stretch but proved no match in late stages. PTARMIGAN MOUNTAIN switched off the inside early to track the leaders between foes in the second flight, was urged to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch but failed to sustain that effort while continuing well enough to prevail for a share. WEALTH MANAGEMENT broke in the air, was settled in last racing to the backstretch, shifted out four wide on the far turn while being urged to advance, gained some position nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. SEVENTYTWO was urged to secure a forward placing three deep racing into the first turn, prompted the pacesetter racing into the far turn but soon gave way. HOLY UNO raced three deep between foes as part of the second flight in the opening stages, angled to the inside on the backstretch while dropping back from that position and couldn't produce the needed late response. VIA DELOROSA, caught four wide in the second flight racing to the backstretch, dropped out after a half.
