Footnotes

SICOMORO urged to the fore along the inside racing into the first turn, disputed the lead inside foes racing into the far turn, then edged clear under brisk handling racing through the stretch. SUMMER'S EMPIRE, held up in close quarters between foes racing into the first turn, settled off the second flight in the opening half, shifted out four wide on the far turn advancing to striking distance, couldn't match terms with the winner but proved best of the others. RIVER OF NO RETURN settled three deep between foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, made some progress while being fanned five wide leaving the far turn and continued to improve his position in that path while earning a share. YONA TORY settled between foes in the opening stages, shifted out five deep nearing the far turn, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch but continued with an effort to improve his placing. HIGH STAKES SILVER broke

readily, prompted a rival's pace racing to the backstretch, dueled between foes for command racing through the far turn and gave way nearing midstretch. SERENGETI TOUR, held up in close quarters near the inside just off the second flight racing into the first turn, exchanged some contact with POWER CHIPPED near the seven furlong marker, continued along the inside into the backstretch, shifted out to split foes racing through the far turn while being urged to advance but had no final kick. WHO'S THERE angled in to track the pace outside a rival in the second flight racing to the backstretch, steadily retreated racing through the far turn. NICKY'S DELIGHT was guided to the inside early settling as part of the last flight and never gained striking distance. RULEROUS broke awkwardly, was reserved while caught wide to the backstretch and never gained contention. MERCURY EXPRESS tracked just off the first flight along the inside in the opening half and steadily faded racing through the far turn. CORNEL NOBLE, held up a bit off the second flight in early stages, shifted out three wide making some early progress racing to the backstretch, continued in that path making a brief bid entering the far turn but failed to sustain that effort through the final quarter. POWER CHIPPED was steadied sharply between foes after exchanging some contact with SERENGETI TOUR racing into the first turn and never menaced thereafter.
