Footnotes

BOBBY SANDS, held up just off the first flight in the opening half, made a steady advance to challenge three wide racing through the far turn, wrested command in upper stretch and went clear under steady pressure. SHORE BREEZE ICON, reserved off the second flight in the opening stages, angled inside foes gaining position after a half, swung four wide entering upper stretch and proved best of the others while no menace to the winner. CATMANTOO settled off the inside in the opening stages, angled out entering upper stretch to improve his position and gain a share. CAPTURED RED MAGIC, reserved along the inside in the opening half, continued evenly while passing some tiring foes late. JUMP TO START was urged to the lead inside foes from the break, dueled for command into the far turn and gave way. FACE THE FIRE, prominent between foes from the break, forced the pace outside a rival to the backstretch, dueled between foes into the second turn and gave way nearing midstretch. B L'S TSUMANI tracked the leaders three wide in second flight racing to the backstretch, then steadily retreated after a half. BRIAN'S PEAK tracked outside foes in the second flight but dropped out of contention early.
