TABLE GAMES was held up along the rail behind the second flight in the opening stages, made solid progress after a half to gain a striking position just off the leaders along the inside, awaited an opening racing through the second bend, shifted out to split foes three wide in upper stretch and was roused clear in the last furlong. SPATZEL was urged to a contending position while caught four wide racing into the first turn, made steady progress outside foes to challenge for command three or four deep after six furlongs, disputed the issue outside the winner past midstretch but proved only second best. MAXTON angled inwards to track off the first flight near the inside in the opening quarter, continued between foes while losing some position after a half, shifted out in upper stretch to challenge five deep between foes, couldn't match the top pair but continued willingly to earn a share. FUN ON THE BAYOU, held up three wide between foes in the opening half, made steady progress in that position racing through the far turn, angled out six wide in upper stretch and finished evenly in the last furlong. LINCOLNSHIRE was urged to secure a forward placing racing into the first turn, pressed the pace between foes entering the far turn and emptied out in the drive. AFLEET PADDY settled saving ground in the opening half, swung outside foes racing through the far turn and continued evenly while improving his position. CAPTAIN AMERICAN shifted off the inside early tracking off the second flight, was caught five wide racing through the far turn and steadily faded. HISTORICALLY settled outside foes in the opening half and offered no rally. SMARTY SPRINGS raced unhurried between foes into the backstretch and never mounted a serious challenge. LIMESTONE broke in the air, was collected to track off the second flight near the inside racing to the backstretch but lacked response after a half. DOCTOR TROTTER never seriously menaced. AKAPESCHE was urged to the lead inside foes, duelled

for command into upper stretch, was pulled up leaving the furlong marker while racing in traffic and was vanned off the course after the race.
