**Footnotes**

NO BULL JESS broke readily to secure a forward placing tracking the pacesetter from just out of striking distance under light rating racing to the turn, made steady progress to challenge that foe for command on his own courage racing into upper stretch, wrested command when given his cue and drew well clear under some right handed prompting. SPENCERS CHOICE hopped at the start, then was taken in hand avoiding close quarters at the break, steadily gathered momentum entering the turn while switching outside foes, swung five wide leaving the midway point of the bend, continued with a steady effort in that path racing into upper stretch and prevailed for place honors nearing the wire. YES SIR OFFICER shifted out early to track just off the second flight in the opening stages, made a steady advance to contention in the three path racing through the bend to upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner and was outfinished for second. MOB BOSS tracked off the second flight outside a rival racing to the turn, shifted out to split foes three deep nearing midstretch and continued evenly to late stages while gaining some position. MAC DOOGLE angled inwards to track the leaders between foes in the second flight racing into the bend, shifted out four wide nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. BIGTIME MAC tracked the pace inside foes in the second flight in the opening quarter, saved ground to upper stretch and steadily faded in late stages. ROYAL JAKE sprinted clear of the field from the break, set the pace off the rail to upper stretch but faltered once he was headed by the winner. JOE MATT settled outside foes in the opening stages and never mounted a serious challenge. DEAL OF A LIFETIME, caught in some tight quarters at the start, settled into stride along the inside but dropped out early.
