LASSELL was urged to secure terms with a rival on the pace from the outset, pressed the issue entering the bend to gain a narrow advantage between foes after a half, then maintained that margin through the stretch to the wire under brisk handling. SMOKIN GLOCK was eased off the pace in the opening stages to track the leaders off the inside, steadily drew into contention inside foes on the turn, shifted out to split foes three deep in upper stretch, contested the issue outside the winner to the end but couldn't gain even terms with that foe. EMILE tracked just off the first flight five deep racing through the backstretch, made steady progress in that path to challenge for command racing into upper stretch, loomed outside the top pair near midstretch but lacked the needed final bid. TALL GRASS CAT settled off the second flight remaining off the inside in the opening stages, advanced to contention four deep between foes racing into upper stretch but finished evenly in late stages. DELSTAR was urged to the lead along the inside from the break, dueled for command racing into the turn, couldn't match the winner's tempo and gave way leaving midstretch. GATA YOT shifted nearer to the inside early while dropping off the pace, continued between foes into the turn but offered no closing bid. SHOWBIZ IS MY BIZ, bumped at the start, was righted to gain a contending position just off the leaders racing four wide into the turn, lodged a brief bid in that path between foes nearing upper stretch but quickly emptied out in the drive. GAMBLIN JACK broke outwards bumping SHOWBIZ IS MY BIZ, was righted, then urged along three deep in pursuit of the leaders racing into the bend, ducked out leaving the quarter mile marker and emptied out abruptly.
