Footnotes

WADE FOR ME settled in near the middle of the field and along the rail, checked lacking room turning for home, split horses in the stretch, rallied to the front late and held ROYAL BANDITA safe. ROYAL BANDITA was void of early speed, entered the stretch five wide and gained steadily for the place but could not get to the winner. FACCIA BELLA lacked speed, came six wide into the stretch and gained belatedly for minor honors. COME SEPTEMBER went up to press the pace from the outside and remained a factor in the stretch but weakened. LADY LOUWANE raced close up from the start, came four wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. LU KEEL raced close up inside and tired. DARLING L raced near the middle of the field and gave way. PRIZE AND JOY was always outrun. PRAIRIE SPRING set the pace from the rail while pressed and tired. DOC'S BETTER CHOP lacked speed and was pulled up in the stretch.
