OUT FOR A SPIN raced close up off the rail, rallied to the lead in deep stretch and held sway in the run to the wire. HIGH EXPECTATIONS lacked speed inside, angled out and rallied but missed in the drive. ALABAMA CLAY reared at the break, lacked speed then rallied belatedly for a share. JIMMY'S BOY set the pace from the inside on a clear lead but weakened. DISTORTED GROOM raced close up inside and tired. IRON ROGUE gave way in the drive.
